OPTIONAL FEES: You will have the opportunity to **add payments** for the following fees.

Co-Curricular Fee:

At the middle school level, students who choose to participate in any of the activities listed below are assessed a one-time fee of \$10/year. This Co-Curricular fee is paid only once during the school year, regardless of the number of activities your child participates in.

Grades 6 - 8 - cross country, wrestling, track, and forensics

Grades 7 & 8 - volleyball, basketball

<u>Volleyball T-shirt</u>: \$15 - required of 7th grade and new 8th grade volleyball players only; returning 8th grade volleyball players should use their T-shirt from the previous year.

NURSING SERVICES: If you have a student with medical needs, please contact our school nurse. At (920)898-4769 ask for Mrs. Vanderlinden or email her at mvanderlinden@nhsd.k12.wi.us. It is important that school beware of any medical conditions or medication your students is on in case of emergency.

ABSENCES: Absences are excusable only for school activities, illness, medical or dental appointments, accidents, marriage or death in the family, or other legitimate prior approved family matters (up to 10 days per school year/5 days per semester). The school must be notified via a telephone call of a student's absence prior to 8:30 a.m. on the day of the absence. If this is not accomplished, the absence will be considered unexcused. (BOE Policies 5200, 5223, 8330)

For other than excusable absences, excessive absences (5 per semester) will result in a letter mailed to the parents/legal guardian requesting a conference. If such absences continue after the conference, action will follow due process of the law. Wisconsin statutes allow a school administrator to request a physician's verification of illness from students who are absent. (BOE Policies 5200, 5223, 8330)
